



REGISTRATION AND FIRST RESIDENCE PERMIT/ FIRST RESIDENCE PERMIT

ΜΕΤΑ ΤΗΝ ΑΦΙΞΗ ΤΟΥ ΥΠΗΚΟΟΥ ΤΡΙΤΗΣ ΧΩΡΑΣ

1.	Copy of a valid passport or other travel document, valid for at least three (3) months beyond the requested duration of stay.
2.	Copy of the passport or travel document page showing the latest entry stamp into the Republic and the relevant visa (where applicable).
3.	Original Certificate of Criminal Record from the country of origin (if the applicant resides in a country other than the country of origin, the certificate should be issued from the country of residence). Ratification is necessary, except in the presence of a bilateral state agreements providing for an exception.
4.	Original results of medical tests, performed in Cyprus, showing that the third country national does not bear/suffer from HIV, Syphilis, Hepatitis B and C and Tuberculosis - TB (through chest x-ray), certified from a Specialised Doctor in Cyprus.
5.	Original bank guarantee letter issued by a banking institution in the Republic, valid for ten (10) years, covering possible repatriation expenses, issued in the name of the applicant, either from the applicant's own bank account in the Republic or from the School/Organization where the Course will be attended. If issued by the School/Organization, the guarantee may be group/ collective.
6.	Valid Certificate of Health Insurance for medical care that covers inpatient and outpatient care as well as transportation of corpse (Plan A), automatically renewable.
7.	<u>Proof of address</u> : title deed or rental agreement (duly stamped where applicable), or a host's declaration providing suitable accommodation.
8.	Official confirmation letter from the competent authority, regarding the approval of the operation of the School/ Organization where the Course will be attended.
9.	Certificate of enrolment of the third country national in an approved School/Organization for attendance of a specific Course (specifying the duration (≥4 months) and the starting date of each course), duly stamped by the competent authority.
10.	Confirmation from the School/Organization that the third country national meets the admission requirements of the institution.
11.	Proof of payment of the registration fee and part of the Course fees.
12.	<p>Certificate from a banking institution in the Republic (detailed bank account statement), showing that the third country national has transferred foreign currency from personal or direct ascendants' income abroad into a personal account in Cyprus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • at least €24,000 to cover accommodation, subsistence, and Course tuition expenses, <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • at least €10,000, provided the applicant can prove additional sufficient and stable income from abroad of at least €14,000 (income may include salary, pension, deposits in a foreign bank account, rent, dividends, or interest, belonging to the applicant or their direct ascendants), thus ensuring a minimum annual income of €24,000 as required. <p><u>Note</u>: If the total Course duration is less than one year, the amount shall be calculated proportionally to the duration and must cover at least €2,000 per month of attendance.</p>

1.	Copy of a valid passport or other travel document, valid for at least three (3) months beyond the requested duration of stay.
2.	Copy of original bank guarantee letter issued by a banking institution in the Republic, valid for ten (10) years, covering possible repatriation expenses, issued in the name of the applicant, either from the applicant's own bank account in the Republic or from the School/Organization where the Course will be attended. If issued by the School/Organization, the guarantee may be group/ collective.
3.	Valid Certificate of Health Insurance for medical care that covers inpatient and outpatient care as well as transportation of corpse (Plan A), automatically renewable.
4.	<u>Proof of address</u> : title deed or rental agreement (duly stamped where applicable), or a host's declaration providing suitable accommodation.
5.	Recent confirmation from the School/Organization, dully stamped by the competent authority, that attendance continues, accompanied by a progress report including detailed grades for classes attended up to the date of application submission.
6.	Proof of payment of part of the tuition fees.
7.	Recent detailed bank account statement showing that the third country national has again transferred foreign currency from personal or direct ascendants' income abroad into a personal account in Cyprus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • at least €24,000 to cover accommodation, subsistence, and tuition expenses, OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • at least €10,000, provided the applicant can prove additional sufficient and stable income from abroad of at least €14,000 (income may include salary, pension, deposits in a foreign bank account, rent, dividends, or interest, belonging to the applicant or their direct ascendants), ensuring the minimum annual income of €24,000 required.
